Learn about the dramatic role that Fort Ticonderoga played in the French & Indian War And the Revolutionary War

Join a group of teachers at Fort Ticonderoga this summer with room, board, and site expenses paid by the Living History Education Foundation. (LHEF)*

Utilizing a wealth of materials and techniques participants will immerse themselves in the history of New York and Canada during the Colonial and Revolutionary Periods.

Participants will study the social, military, economic, geographic, technology, music and cultural factors, which have shaped the history of the US, Canada and New York.

The experience includes an 18th century encampment in period dress plus a canoe or bateau experience (furnished by LHEF). Teachers will utilize a cross curriculum approach with Living History experiences based on the NYS Standards and Character Education recommendations.
